Discussion Item	Resolution Providing for an Appointment to the Committee on the Environment
Background	<p>The Committee on the Environment was reestablished Ordinance 2012-37 with the following purpose:</p> <p>A. To advise the City Council on all environmental issues, including, but not limited to, stormwater management, greenhouse gas reduction, air quality, tree protection, open space conservation, biodiversity, watershed functioning and restoration, energy use, transportation, energy conservation, and recycling;</p> <p>B. To serve in partnership with the City Council and Takoma Park City staff to work together to achieve sustainability and other environmental certifications that may help the City meet and be recognized for its environmental goals.</p> <p>Eleven to 15 members are to be appointed to staggered two-year terms with initial appointments of one and two years. Terms begin on July 1 and expire on June 30. There are currently 12 members on the Committee.</p> <p>Shannon Baker-Branstetter (Ward 2); Denis Borum (Ward 6); Paul Chrostowski (Ward 1); Cindy Dyballa (Ward 2); Sat Jiwan Ikle-Khalsa (Ward 2); Lauren Marshall (Ward 1); Sarah Mazur (Ward 1); Riaz Mohammed (Ward 6); Allyson Piazza (Ward 2); Lindsey Robinett (Ward 6); Kirby Rootes-Murdy (Ward 4); and Thomas Simchak (Ward 3).</p> <p>Jamey Gerlaugh (Ward 1) has applied to serve on the Committee. His application has been provided to the City Council for review.</p>
